**Pool Rules and Regulations**

HOURS: 11:00 AM to 8:00 PM \* Monday through Thursday  
11:00 AM to 10:00 PM\* Friday  
(During weekdays while schools are in session, pool hours will be 4:00 – 7:00 PM and may be further changed upon posting of notice at Clubhouse)  
12:00 noon to 7:00 PM Saturday and Sunday; Open 11 a.m. Saturdays in June

The lifeguards or other authorized pool management personnel may close the pool because of the weather, safety reasons, health department rules or any other reason pool management may deem necessary. The lifeguards and/or manager have complete authority to remove any person for any reason. Reasons may include but not be limited to rule breaking, improper behavior or improper swimming attire. Hours may be modified upon notice if there is a lack of membership participation in late evening swim hours or upon the discretion of management. Any of the rules and regulations of the pool may be immediately modified upon the posting of notice at the pool.

1. Only swim suits may be worn in the water. NO cut-offs gym shorts, etc.
2. SHOWERS MUST BE TAKEN BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL. (State Law)
3. No shoes will be allowed on the pool deck. (State Law)
4. Absolutely no rollerblades or skateboards allowed in the clubhouse, restrooms or on pool deck.
5. No glass, sharp objects or rafts are allowed, except for flotation devices provided by Smokey Row Family Swim Club, Inc.
6. Food is restricted to designated eating areas only.
7. Please do not visit with lifeguards while they are working. Please wait until adult swim or until they rotate off duty to visit with them.
8. Poolside loungers are reserved for adults only (18 and over).
9. ABSOLUTELY NO RUNNING OR ROUGH PLAY will be allowed in or around the facility.
10. Do not leave personal belongings such as swim bags, clothing, shoes, etc on tables and/or chairs. If you do not have a lounge, please store your items in the cubicles provided in the picnic area. Keeping personal belongings on the table is a health code violation.

11. No hard balls, tennis balls, or rubber balls are allowed. Only soft beach balls are allowed to be thrown in or around the pool.
12. Only one person at a time will be allowed on the diving board. Do not linger under the diving boards. Be sure to dive straight off the diving board and swim toward the ladders.
13. All baby diapers must be changed in the baby station. Baby diapers may not be changed on the pool deck as this is a health code violation.
14. Adult swim will be called at any time if all bicycles, tricycles, wagons or strollers are not parked in the bike rack. Swimmers will not be allowed to return to the pool until all bicycles, tricycles, wagons and strollers are parked in the bike rack or bike rack area.
15. Adult swims (18 and over) will be called by the lifeguard every hour. Non-swimmers who are under the age of 6 may enter the water during this adult swim time only if accompanied by an adult.
16. Babies wearing cloth or disposable diapers will not be allowed in the pools. This is a Health Department rule and exceptions will not be made. Infants/toddlers must wear pool pants or rubber pants. Cloudiness and excessive chlorination results from urine in the pool as well as clogged filters from the breakdown of disposable diapers. Any help with this situation will be appreciated. Swim diapers are available at the concession stand.
17. The baby pool is reserved for non-swimming children under 6 years and must be accompanied by an adult, 18 years or over. The baby pool is not supervised (NO LIFEGUARD) and children are not allowed in the baby pool or baby pool area without their parents or guardians. Children over six may not at any time enter the baby pool. Absolutely no rough play will be allowed in this area. Parents, please monitor your children closely in this area.
18. CHILDREN 8 AND UNDER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT, 18 OR OVER. Children over the age of 8 must be capable of swimming the length of the pool unassisted if not accompanied by an adult 18 or over.
19. All children 5 and under must be accompanied by an adult or guardian into the restrooms.
20. This is a non-smoking facility. No smoking is allowed in the building, on the pool deck or grassy areas.
21. Persons having infectious diseases, open sores, bandages, cuts or recent vaccinations must not enter the pool area.
22. The shallow end (west end) of the pool between the two ladders is reserved for our younger members.
23. The pool will close early (around 3:00 PM) on certain Tuesday and Thursday evenings for home swim meets. There are usually between 4 to 5 home swim meets

per swim season. A list of home swim meet dates will be posted on the clubhouse bulletin board when available.

24. Outside air temperature must be at least 70 degrees Fahrenheit before the pool can be opened or remain open during the day.
25. Family memberships are defined to include those persons who are a parent or parents to one or more minor children (including newborns, infants, and toddlers). This may also include a mother, father, or other relative who is permanently living in your home.
26. "Adults Only" memberships are reserved for those person(s) who have no minor children living at home.
27. Members who provide day care for children who are not pool members and whose intention is to bring those children to the pool must pay a one-time fee of \$50.00 per child.
28. No pro-rated memberships are offered by Smokey Row Family Swim Club except for those persons new to Carmel after July 15<sup>th</sup>. There will be absolutely no exceptions to this rule. No refunds of membership fees are allowed except in extraordinary situations approved in the sole discretion of management of Smokey Row Family Swim Club, Inc. Any request for a refund must be submitted in writing.
29. Smokey Row Family Swim Club will not issue refunds to those members who fail to recognize or understand the Rule and Regulations.
30. GUEST PASSES: Guest pass booklets are available at the concession stand and each pass costs \$6.00. Guest passes may be purchased by members only. You must possess a membership in order to purchase guest passes.
31. Should there be a question of membership, the list will be checked for verification by a member of management or other authorized personnel. If it is rendered that the persons(s) entering the pool area are not members or are not accompanied by a member and possess a guest pass, they will be required to leave the premises.
32. The Smokey Row Family Swim Club may not be open during certain days or hours that Carmel Clay Schools are in session. It may also close at any time deemed necessary to prevent bees from becoming a nuisance.
33. Absolutely no pets or animals are allowed in the clubhouse, restroom or on pool deck.
34. ALL GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A POOL MEMBER BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL. EACH GUEST (INCLUDING INFANTS AND TODDLERS) MUST ALSO POSSESS A GUEST PASS. ALL MEMBERS SHOULD SIGN IN ON THE MEMBERSHIP LIST AND BRING THEIR MEMBERSHIP PASS EACH DAY THAT THEY ARE AT THE POOL.
